

Cookie Policy

This policy applies to the web site of Jini Hypnotherapy at <http://jinihypnotherapy.co.uk>, which is owned by Susan McHale and was designed and is hosted by Sure Technologies Ltd.

We are required by the UK 'Cookie Law' to disclose the purpose for which we use cookies, and thereby to give users the choice of whether they wish to continue using the site or not.

This website uses cookies. By using this website and agreeing to this policy, you consent to Jini Hypnotherapy's use of cookies in accordance with the terms of this policy.

About Cookies

Cookies are small text files sent by web servers to web browsers, and stored by the web browsers.

The information is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server. This enables a web server to identify and track web browsers.

There are two main kinds of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are deleted from your computer when you close your browser, whereas persistent cookies remain stored on your computer until deleted, or until they reach their expiry date.

User Login

If you log into the private user area of Jini Hypnotherapy, a session cookie is placed on your computer so that if you request a page in the secure area, we know who it is who is requesting it. This enables us to secure our server and database against unlawful intrusion (hacking) as well as offer the service to you. The cookie contains your username, and no other identifiable information. It is deleted when you log out, when you close the browser window, or 4 hours after you log in irrespective of what other actions you perform.

Third Party Cookies

Jini Hypnotherapy uses Google Analytics to analyse the use of this website so that we can improve the services we provide to our visitors. Google Analytics generates statistical and other information about website use by means of cookies, which are stored on users' computers. The information generated relating to our website is used to create reports about the use of the website. Google will store and use this information. Google's privacy policy is available at:
